Plot Summary:

Mirror Dance is the 10th in the Miles Vorkosigan series of space adventures. Miles is an outstanding character: damaged in a uterine replicator and consequently dwarfed and brittle; heir to Lord Vorkosigan and cousin to the Emperor on Barrayar, a planet with much history including traditional roles for women and an intolerance for 'mutants' like Miles; determined to advance in spite of his disabilities; creator of an alternate identity Admiral Naismith of the Dendarii Mercenaries and as such an accomplished and daring warrior; and now, brother to clone Mark. In this novel, Mark, masquerading as Miles as Admiral Naismith has escaped his watchers and leading a crack team of the Dendarii attempts to rescue and liberate other clones being held in the crèche on Jackson's Whole. During the rescue, Miles attempts to rescue Mark and Miles is killed, packed up in a cryonics case, and lost in the mail. This is another great entry in a marvelous character and plot driven series.
